ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

- **APPROVAL PROCESS:** All applications (new & returning) are reviewed before a student is approved for enrollment. Enrollment Fee payments must accompany applications before approval process may begin.
- **ENROLLMENT FEE:** An Enrollment Fee is due with the application form and is non-refundable. Please refer to page 1 of the application for cost.
- **TUITION RATES:** Ask about our "Paid in Full" discount (5% off if paid by the 1st day of August) and our Sibling Discount.

K4 – 12th Grade

Monday-Thursday, 8:00am – 4:00pm; NO School on Fridays
Annual Cost: Refer to page 1 of application.

- **EARLY WITHDRAWAL:** Enrollment is an annual commitment – tuition is due in full for each enrolled student, even with early withdrawal.
- **TUITION – MONTHLY:** Monthly payments are due the 1st of each month (August 1st – May 1st). All tuition payments are non-refundable. GPCA operates solely on tuition fees and depends on all payments being paid promptly. Non-payment for school services and/or lack of adherence to tuition policies may result in dismissal of your child(ren) from the program. A late fee of \$25 per week is added to payments made after the 5th of each month.
- **PAYMENTS:** Make checks payable to "Grace Point Christian Academy" Check payments may be mailed directly to 5934 Surrett Drive, Archdale, NC 27263, or given in person. Cash and money orders must be paid in person and put in a labeled envelope.
- **RETURNED CHECKS:** There is a \$30 processing fee for all returned checks. No exceptions.
- **HOLIDAYS:** Tuition is calculated on an annual basis. We do not pro-rate monthly tuition for holidays or absences due to illness, vacation, or inclement weather.
- **LATE PICK-POLICIES AND FEES:**
4pm Pick-Up Policy and Late Fee: We allow a 15-minute grace period. After 4:15pm, the parent will be charged \$20 and \$5 will be added every 5 minutes the parent/guardian is late after 4:15pm. This fee is due upon pick-up but, may be paid **no later than the following Monday** to avoid additional late payment fees. (** We understand if there are wrecks/natural disasters that may prohibit you from being on time. Please let the school know ASAP if you approach this inconvenience. **)
- **SCHOOL YEAR & HOURS:** Classes start mid-August and run through mid-May. The first day of school for the 2026-27 school year is August 10, 2025. Please refer to your GPCA annual calendar for any holiday information or school breaks. If Randolph County Schools must close or delay due to inclement weather, GPCA will be in consideration of that. We will inform you of any closing or delays via ClassDojo, Facebook, or on MyFox8. School doors open at 7:30am for students (no earlier); school begins at 8:00am and ends at 4:00pm on Monday-Thursday. If you are late to drop your child off at school after 8:00am, you are required to walk your child(ren) in and sign the tardy sign-in sheet – no exceptions.

Grace Point Christian Academy (GPCA) reserves the right, as circumstances may arise, to discharge a student from our school. Parent/Guardian will be consulted before such action is taken.
